Current Nonprofit Allocation Criteria

1. Application criteria

- A. Current 501(c)3 tax exempt status
- B. Geographically located in Boston area
- C. Mission fit with CFN Advisory Board areas of interest: Arts and Culture, Community Development, Human Services, and Youth Development
- D. Applicant's seriousness of intent for the proposed collaboration
- E. Identification of collaborative venture and collaboration partner(s)
- F. Identification of intended community impact/outcome objectives and metrics
- G. Description of how Catalyst Fund assistance can support the proposed collaborative venture
- H. Capacity to undertake proposed collaboration
- I. Complete and thoughtful application to the CFN

3. Available funding capacity

4. Catalyst Fund Manager's application summary assessment

Current Technical Assistance Provider Criteria

- 1. Demonstrated professional experience advising on one or more aspects of nonprofit collaborations (please refer to FAQ for the Catalyst Fund's definition of nonprofit collaboration)**
- 2. Demonstrated experience in one or more of the following mission areas: Arts & Culture, Community Development, Human Services, and Youth Development**
- 3. Commitment to operate within the policies and procedures of the Catalyst Fund, e.g. submitting a complete response to the Catalyst Fund Request for Qualifications**
